

## Tested Summer Kit: Shorts

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Great build and quality  
for the money but  
wayward sizing

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### Endura SingleTrack £40 (£70 with liner)

As we've come to expect from Scottish-based Endura, the SingleTracks are packed with features for the money: a stretchy crotch panel, zippered vents backed by funky lime green mesh and four roomy Velcro-tabbed pockets – two at the front and two at the rear. Then there's the hidden zip pocket. The shorts ooze quality, with a tough but supple Teflon-coated material that's resistant to rain. The waist is elasticated and features that same lime green combo, with buckles to synch in the side and a well placed stretch back panel. In fact, our only gripe is the fit. I'm normally a medium (31-32in waist), but even the smalls were roomy round the waist and needed adjustment, so definitely check before you buy. We like the way that they're available with or without detachable inners so you can wear them with your favourite existing pair or buy a new set. And for the quality and build, £40 is excellent value for money. Inseam: 12.5in.
